FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: Today's portrait of John is quite different from last Sunday's thundering, charismatic figure preaching to the crowds along the Jordan. John has been imprisoned by Herod for publicly denouncing the king's incestuous marriage to Herodías. John knows that his life is about to end. This was an anxious time of doubt and despair for John – he had staked his life on proclaiming the long-expected Messiah would come, and his witness would soon cost him his life. John had to wonder if he had been deluding himself. Truth be told, John and the people of Judaism had been expecting a much different kind of Messiah than the gentle, humble worker of wonders from Nazareth; so John sends friends to ask Jesus if he is, in fact, the Messiah Israel had been waiting for. Jesus sends the messengers back to John to report all they have seen Jesus do, fulfilling the prophecies of Isaiah and the prophets of old. Praising John for his faithful witness to the Messiah, Jesus promises his hearers that great things will come to all who become prophets of the reign of God.
