FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: Today's passage from John 21 marks a further step in the development of Easter faith. Some of the disciples are at work at their old profession of fishing in the Sea of Galilee. Then some surprising things begin to happen quickly. First they come to recognize the risen Jesus on the shore. When Peter hears, "It is the Lord," he jumps into the water. Then the disciples share a meal with him. Finally the risen Jesus confirms Peter in his pastoral mission, "Feed my lambs." There is an interesting correlation between what happens to the disciples and what happens to us in the Christian life. Just as Peter recognises the risen Lord and leaps into the waters, so Christians profess their faith in the risen Jesus, so we share in the Eucharist on a regular basis with him. And just as the risen Jesus commissions Peter to undertake a pastoral mission on his behalf, so the natural consequence of baptism and the Eucharist is to share ourselves and our faith with others.
