FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: Today's selection from Luke 21 ends with a sentence that is unique to Luke's version of the apocalyptic discourse, "your endurance will win you your lives." The word translated as "endurance" is sometimes rendered as "patience" or "perseverance." These are not popular virtues in twenty-first century Britain. We want fast food, fast cars, and fast computers. We have short attention spans and we communicate in sound bites and instant emails. However, the kind of endurance recommended in today's Gospel text is not apathy or laziness or timidity. In the biblical concept of endurance there is an element of active resistance in the face of opposition. It is inspired by confidence and hope in God. Hope and endurance are two sides of the same coin. Hope without endurance is anxiety and ends in madness. Perseverance without hope leads to resignation, fatalism and indifference. As Christians we hope for the full coming of God's kingdom, the resurrection of the dead, the last judgement and just rewards and punishments. We expect that all these events will come about in God's own time and way. In the meantime, we try to conduct our lives as people of faith, hope, and love, fully aware of the fragility of human existence and of the world around us. In the midst of fast-paced change, we need the biblical kind of patience and endurance to live one day at a time, seizing the moment and living it to its fullness, all the while moving forward in hope to eternal life in God's Kingdom.
