**FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION:** The season of Advent begins with Jesus' sobering warning – Stay awake! (a warning echoed by the Apostle Paul in his letter to the Romans, in today's second reading). For Matthew's community, Christ's return as the judge of the living and the dead was imminent; the chilling images of today's gospel are intended to call Matthew's church to vigilance for the end of this world and preparation for the beginning of the next – an event they believed they would see in their lifetimes. But today's Gospel can also be read/heard by the Church and Christians of every time and place as a sobering, unsettling reminder that this life of ours is indeed limited, that the moments we have been given are precious and few, that death is a reality all of us will one day face. The First Sunday of Advent calls us to "stay awake" and not sleep through the opportunities life gives us to discover God and the things of God; these Advent days compel us to "watch," to pay attention to the signs of God's unmistakable presence in our lives.
