GIFT AID: If you are a UK tax payer, you can 'gift aid' your contributions to the parish – this allows us to claim 25p from the government for every £1 you donate. It is such a good way to boost parish funds. All you need to do is complete a Gift Aid Declaration. Please contact the Parish Office if you would like a form. If you donate via the digital collection station at St Catherine's, you do not even need to complete a form. Just enter your details on the reader when prompted, and gift aid will be claimed automatically each time you donate using the same card.
