LOVE THE STRANGER AND THE ILLEGAL MIGRATION ACT: In response to the passing of the Illegal Migration Bill in Parliament in July, Bishop Paul McAleenan, the lead Bishop for Migrants and Refugees, has stated 'This legislation stands at odds with the teaching of the church on welcoming, protecting, promoting and integrating refugees'.
