FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: The Third Sunday of Advent is known as "Gaudete Sunday," from one of the Latin words for "rejoice" (gaudere). The title comes from the first words in today's reading from Paul's Letter to the Thessalonians, "Rejoice at all times." Unfortunately, our translation is much less satisfactory, "Be happy at all times." In the first reading, from Isaiah, a messianic (anointed) figure announces that he has been sent by God to usher in the age of salvation for Jerusalem and all God's people. Jesus used this prophecy to announce the programme of his own ministry (Luke 4:16-21. At the end of the reading Jerusalem is represented as exulting with joy in the good news brought to her. The subject of the gospel is the same as that of last Sunday: the witness of John the Baptist who summons all to faith in Jesus. More firmly even than Mark, John casts the Baptist in the role of witness to the light. The Baptist declares that he is not the Messiah. Nor is he Elijah, who was expected to proceed the Messiah. Nor is he the prophet (like Moses) who was to come. He is the voice of the wilderness prophet of Isaiah. His task is to prepare the way for the Messiah, who is already among the people, though they do not recognise him.
