ST CATHERINE'S TEA AND COFFEE AFTER MASS: the next date is this Sunday 3rd December (First Sunday of Advent).

FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: Advent is a wreath of evergreen, a symbol of life, of growth, of hope. It's the overture to the Church's year. The theme, the focus, is salvation. Not some abstract, flimsy pie-in-the-sky. The message is startling: God Himself will come to save. Both Isaiah and Mark sum up in a single word what the Church expects of us during Advent: "Prepare!" Prepare for the coming of Christ. Not for his first coming; that has come and gone. Prepare for his return. Mark's exhortation to "stay awake" includes a parable. Like many of the parables of Jesus it has become something of an allegory in the tradition. The "man travelling abroad" is Jesus, shortly to go on a "journey" to the Father through death and resurrection. The servants are the faithful. They are not simply to lie about idly awaiting his return. Each has his or her "task" to do, but it is the one who must watch the door, the gatekeeper, who particularly illustrates the watchfulness required of all. The master does not want to be pinned down to a preannounced time of arrival. In line with master-slave relationships of the time, he has no scruple in expecting his slaves to be awake and ready to receive him when he arrives, and will be greatly displeased to find them asleep. Hence their only proper course is to stay awake through all the watches of the night. When scripture focuses on Christ's final coming, the stress is not on when and how. Interesting issues, of course, but not crucial. The crucial question is, whenever Christ comes, however he comes, will we be ready?
