FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: For the ancient, salt was one of the most important necessities of human life, for everything from preserving and seasoning food to making covenants. The rabbis compared the Torah to salt. The point of the parable is that the disciples have an important, vital function to play in the world. If the disciples lose their sense of moral fervour and stop witnessing to the world by their good deeds, they are as useless as salt from the Dead Sea, which, because of chemical impurities, could decompose and lose its taste. In the Fourth Gospel, Jesus says: "I am the light of the world" (8:12). If Jesus is 'the light of the world' his disciples are meant to enlighten in their measure. The Christian is a lamp designed to give the light: One betrays one's calling it one lives only for oneself. Christians ought to bear witness to Christ before fellow Christians and before unbelievers. This is their calling. They do not have to go out of their way to do it; the authenticity of their lives is the best witness.
