FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: With chapter 14, John's Gospel begins a series of farewell discourses that extends through to chapter 17. Jesus' statements are mainly assurances to his disciples about the importance of faith and love and promises that the disciples will receive divine help in the absence of the earthly Jesus. The first Paraclete (translated "Advocate" in the Jerusalem Bible, which we use at Mass) passage explains how the disciples will be able to carry on in the future without the presence of the earthly Jesus. The Greek word *parakletos* ("someone called to the side of") is a legal term; it means an 'advocate,' designating one who comes to another's aid; supports a defendant in a trial. The "world" (those forces opposed to Jesus and his followers) does not accept the Spirit of truth because it neither sees nor knows the Holy Spirit. Jesus' followers will be given "another Advocate," someone who will stand in for Jesus and continue his work.
