FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: In the Gospel this Sunday we have a dramatic evocation of the last judgement that will determine who gets entrance into the Kingdom. What we hear is not in fact a process of judgement but a pronouncing of sentence. Judgement is already over and done with before the great assize begins. Members of the human race have determined the outcome for themselves according to whether they have acted or neglected to act on behalf of those in need. Everything depends on how one acts or fails to act here and now in the time before judgement. We are told about it in order to communicate the message: "The outcome - after grace - is in your hands, in what you choose to do or fail to do in the present. Do you want to be relieved of the fear of judgement? Well, then, dedicate yourself to this kind of life. Then the judgement will be already behind you."
