FR DAVID'S GOSPEL REFLECTION: Regarded as punished by God, people experiencing severe skin diseases suffered extreme social and religious exclusion as prescribed in Leviticus 13: 45-46. In defiance of this prescription of the Law the man approaches Jesus, beseeching him. Like other desperate figures later in the gospel he displays a faith prepared to break through barriers. The way in which the leper approaches Jesus (begging, kneeling, and praying) suggests that he recognises Jesus' divinity, while Jesus' own reactions (moved with pity, touching, and sternly warning) indicate Jesus' humanity. As we have already seen, the healing is immediate and complete. As an observant Jew, Jesus sends the healed man to a priest in order to obtain an official declaration of his healing, and thus make possible his return to family and society. Despite Jesus' command to be silent, it appears that the healed man cannot resist spreading the word about Jesus, which makes it impossible for Jesus to travel in the towns of Galilee. Ironically, he ends up unable to enter towns and cities, compelled to live the kind of "outcast" and wilderness existence from which the now cleansed man has been set free.
